




WHAT IS WATCH DUTY?

A free emergency alerting service app that provides real-time safety information for wildfires throughout the American West.



WATCH DUTY THE APP

- Available free on iOS, Android, and Web
- Operated as a 501(c)(3) non-profit
- No advertising, sponsorship, or government funding
- No login or signup required download it, set it, and forget it




WATCH DUTY NOTIFICATIONS

We send a steady stream of reports **shortly after ignition** all the way **through evacuations**, until the

last engine leaves.

Three types of incidents

- Full incident
- Silent incident
- Prescribed Fire






WATCH DUTY ELEMENTS

How does Watch Duty work?

WHAT WATCH DUTY IS NOT...

- Crowdsourced
 - Only credentialed reporters can post on Watch Duty. Everyone undergoes training by senior staff as well as background and reference checks.
- Facebook, Twitter, or Nextdoor
 - We are a one-way communication tool moderated by experts
- A "scanner" app
 - We do not report on police activity, structure fires, or traffic accidents
- A government tool such as Nixle, CodeRed, or ZoneHaven
 - We do not replace government tools. In fact, we use them ourselves in our reporting.

WATCH DUTY REPORTS

Our reports are created by over 200 active and retired firefighters, dispatchers, first responders/EMTs, and/or radio operators.

Our reporters monitor radios, police bulletins, internal signals and wildfire cameras to gather information in real-time.

Our collaborators support the effort by gathering and verifying information.

Our team includes approximately 40 ham operators and 30 GMRS licensees. Approximately half the team has at least one FEMA certification.

WHY WATCH DUTY?

- Our alerts arrive 15-30 minutes prior to most government alerts.
- Our alerts are continuous, accompanied by a map, and tell a story about firefighting efforts in real-time.
- We alert you as the incident de-escalates and firefighters gain control
 of the fire, letting you go back to your life.
- Customizable alerts by county
- All information is one place, for free, with no signup. Just download it.




REMOVING INTERNET RADIO DEAD ZONES

LA WILDFIRES 2025

- 2nd most deadly fire(s) in the past 50 years, in California
- 29 killed
- 16,000+ structures destroyed / 40,000 acres
- The first official evac order occurred 80 minutes after first dispatch, ours was just 2 mins
- Errant alerts sent to the wrong regions at the wrong time
- Government websites and systems crashed under load

WATCH DUTY STATS DURING THE LA WILDFIRES

- 2.5 MM new users since the fires started (1MM new on Jan 8th)
- 1.3 billion push notifications sent
- #1 app in the App Store, nationwide during the fires
- 100% up-time, sustaining 100,000 requests per second and 3MM users per minute at peak while government sites were crashing

We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit operated by 15 paid staff on a small budget, managing **200+ volunteers**, and supporting **millions of users**..
